



FLEA TREATMENT PREPARATION

Flea Treatment Preparation

The following steps **MUST** be performed:

- Pets **MUST** be professionally groomed and treated for fleas the same day our professional flea treatment is performed.
- Remove **ALL** items from the floors.
- Remove all articles from under beds, on closet doors and under furniture.
- Vacuum all living areas thoroughly paying special attention to under furniture (couches, beds, etc.).
- Be sure to discard any vacuum bags in sealed plastic bags. For canister vacuums without a bag, make sure to clean with cloth or sponge to ensure there are no fleas or eggs left behind.
- Clean non-carpeted areas with soap and water.
- Clean thoroughly **ALL** areas frequented by pets and wash, dry-clean or destroy all pet bedding.
- Remove pets from the residence. If the you have a fish tank disconnect the air pumps and cover the tanks with plastic sheeting and secured tight.

After Flea Treatment

- You must stay off the floors and upholstered furniture for at least four hours to make sure treated surfaces are dry.
- Vacuum all areas with carpet including under furniture and beds, and closets.
- You may return 2-3 hours after treatment is performed or when product(s) are dry.

Fleas will continue to lay eggs after treatment and will continue to hatch out every 4-5 days. There will be fewer fleas each hatching. If you still continue to see fleas after 21-22 days please call our office for a follow up treatment.
